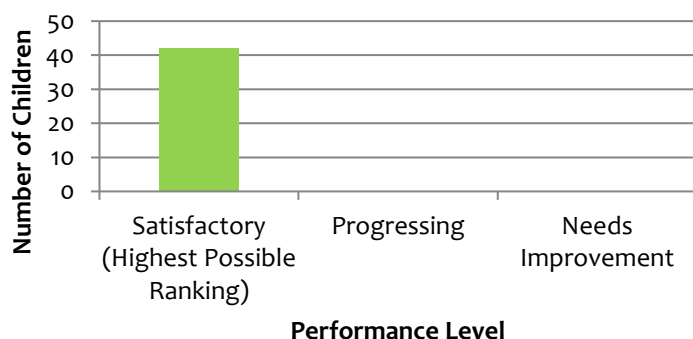




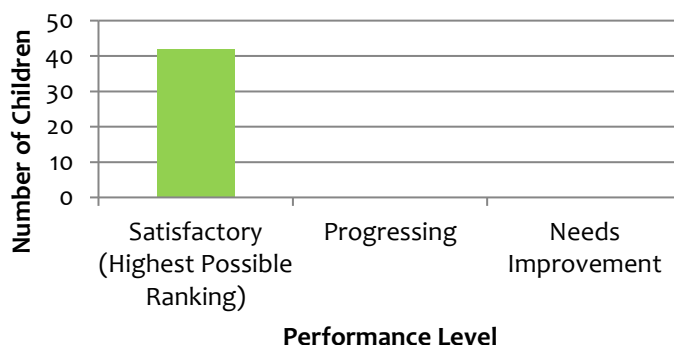
I CAN Pre-School Graduates: Performance Data

Math, Science & Social Studies

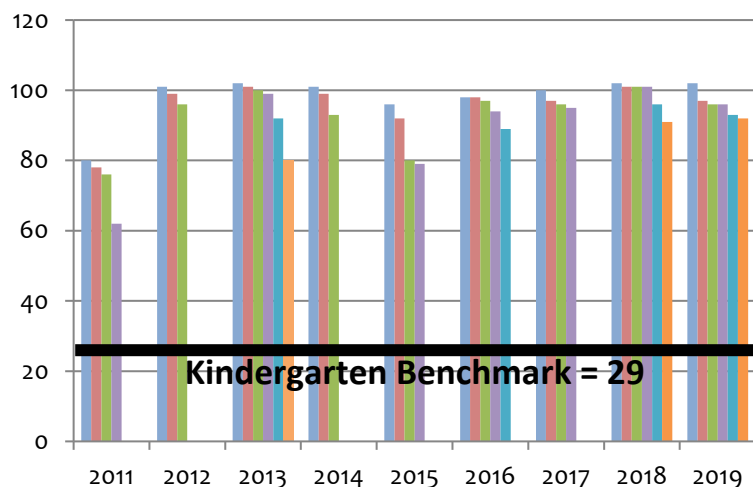


PALS (Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening) administered during 1st nine weeks of school
